Read this text carefully.

Dublin which is the Capital city of the Republic of Ireland is situated on the east coast of Ireland. Its population is estimated at 953.000 inhabitants who live inside and in the suburbs. Dublin is split by the River Liffey, which creates a natural north/ south division. Dublin borders with the Irish Sea to the east and with county Meath to the north, county Kildane to the west and county Wicklow to the south.

The city's name, Baile Atha Cliath (Town of Hurdle Ford) came from early Celtic settlers. By the 10th century, the Vikings arrived and settled there.

However, it was during the 18th century that Dublin began to grow into the city as we know it now. It became the British Empire's second city. In 1916, with the Easter Rising, the Irish nationalists took over various buildings in Dublin

including the general Post Office where the real revolution began. And during the civil war which followed, Ireland became the centre government in an Independent Republic in 1919 when the Irish free-State left the British commonwealth and became the Republic of Ireland in 1921.

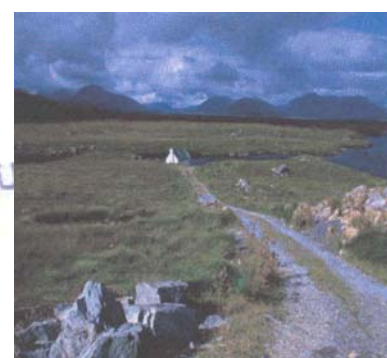

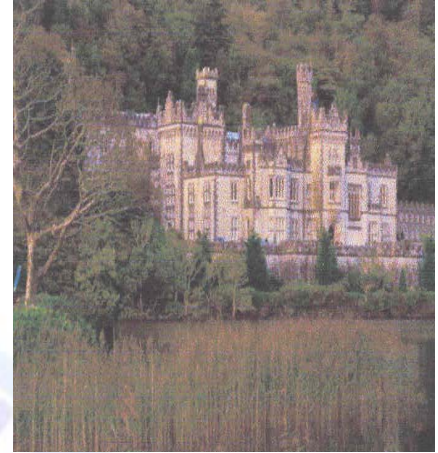
