

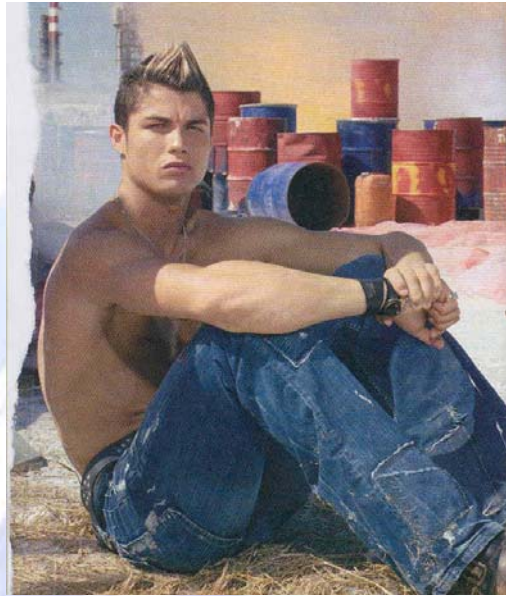

Blue Jeans Culture



The idea that he might one day be hailed as a world fashion leader would surely have given old Levi Strauss a hearty laugh. His famous pants had started out as a roll of tent canvas which he hoped to sell to prospectors on his arrival in California in 1850. Company legend has it that a miner greeted young Strauss with the news that he should have brought pants instead of tent material on the long trip from New York. "Pants don't last at all in the diggings," the miner said, at which point Strauss beat a path to the nearest tailor and ordered more cloth from his brothers in New York. They sent him the now-familiar tough cotton fabric from France, and the miners started pouring into Strauss's store to drop a dollar for a pair of "Levi's pants".

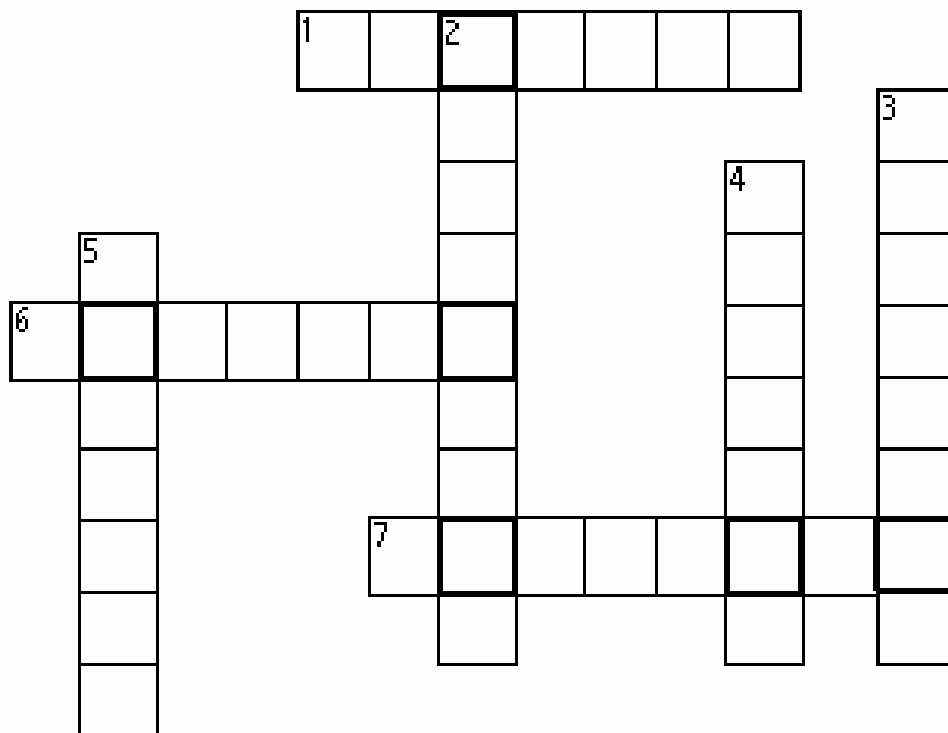
Last year, 75 million pair of pants were sold, a figure which makes Levi Strauss the world's No 1 pants-makers. Levi's have been exhibited in the national museum of science and industry in Washington D.C and presented a special Coty Award as America's most significant contribution to international fashion.

The official Levi tag now goes on more than 2000 items ranging from pants to handbags, notebooks and theatre seats.

But the keystone of the company's operations is still the basic blue jeans, which have remained virtually unchanged for 122 years.

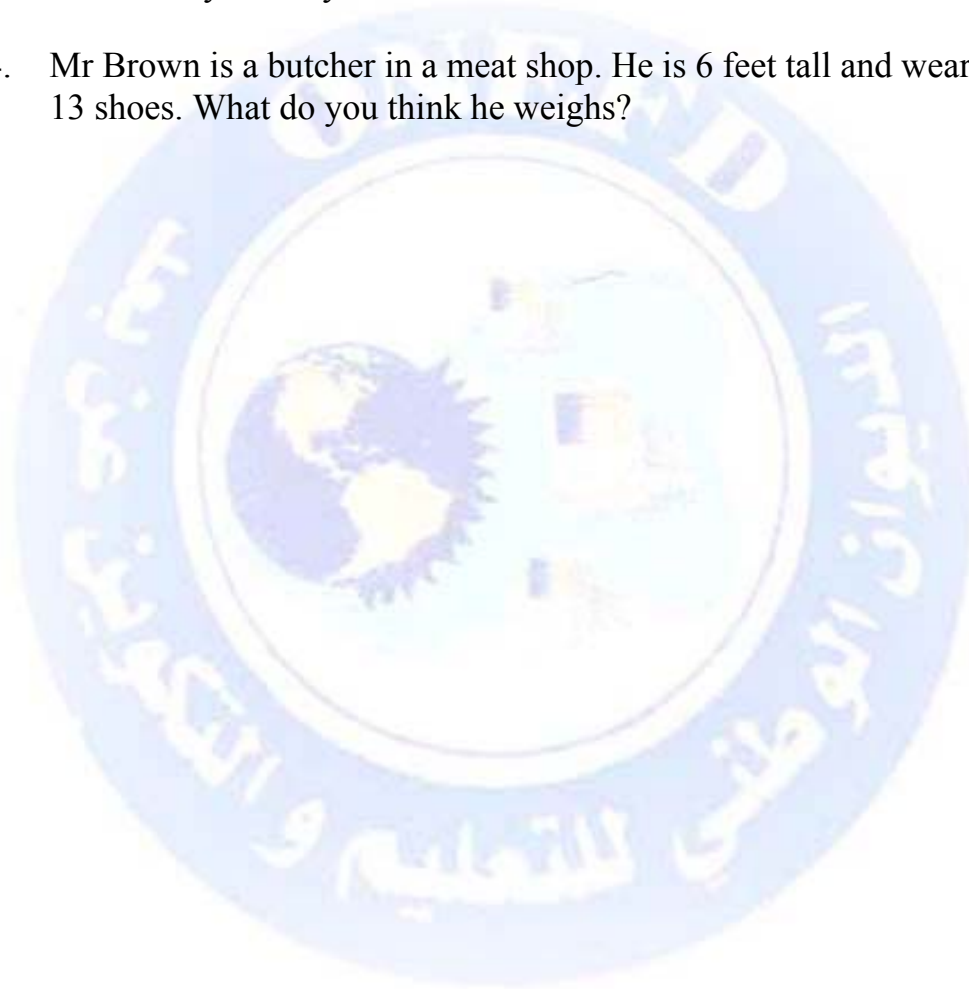
